



# SEVERE RESTRICTIONS NOW IN FORCE\*



**There is a total ban on all outdoor water use**

## Residential

Only use buckets or watering cans containing recycled or grey water on gardens.

No hand-held hoses, sprinklers or garden irrigation systems.

No car or boat washing.

No swimming pool top-ups with town water, consult your pool supplier for advice on managing your pool equipment.

Boat motor flushing is only permitted for 3 minutes, preferably using a container to recycle the flushing water.

## Public areas

Parks, gardens & non-active playing surfaces:  
recycled water only

Active playing areas:

total ban on irrigation systems

Bowling greens & golf courses:

recycled water only

Garden ponds and fountains:

total ban

Public swimming pool top-ups:

permitted with water-use reduction measures

### Save water inside too!

While not part of Level 4 restrictions, please be water-wise and consider how you can save water indoors too!

- Check you have no dripping taps or plumbing leaks.
- Run full loads of washing, or adjust the water level on the washing machine.
- Limit showers to 2 -3 minutes.
